Dhaliwal is also active with SABA North America where he was mostly recently a fellow with the SABA Leadership Institute.

Dhaliwal is also active in the District of Columbia Bar, the largest unified bar in the United States, where he served on the Board of Governors and as Treasurer of the Bar.
